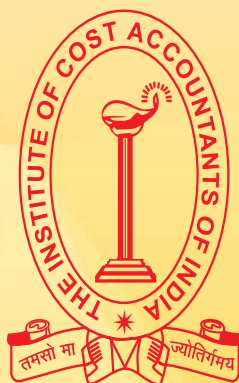

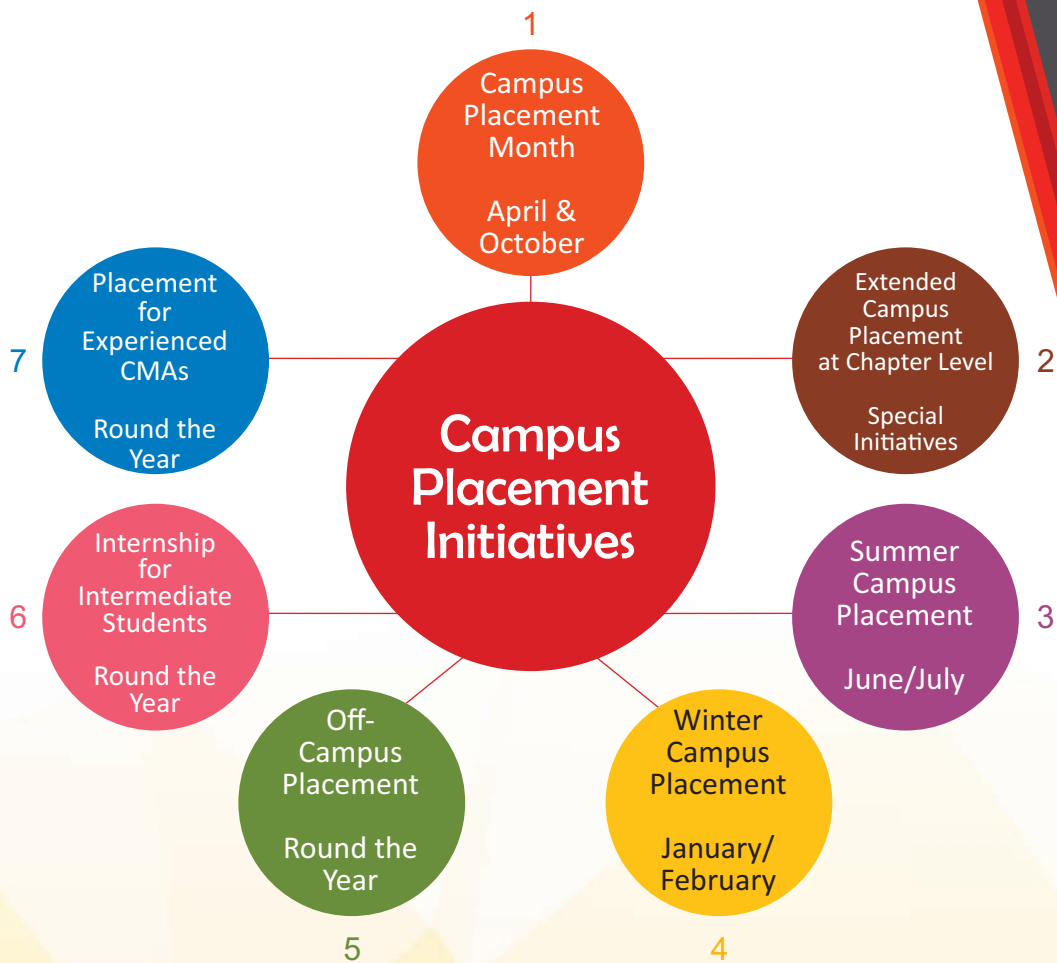
I also thanks to our regular recruiters for reposing continuous faith in us for the last number of years. I approach you to further reinforce this trusting relationship.

In today's era, CMA are specialized in various role such as Managerial Decision, Budgeting And Standard, Production And Service Management, Finance, Cost Audit, Internal Audit, Fund Management Planning etc which ultimately will helps one to reach highest position of professional career.

I have joined CMA after completing my Graduation. Although students can prepare from earliest after completion of Senior Secondary Examination. CMA can be completed in short span of time in compare as compared to other professional courses and that drove me to join this course.

During intermediate, Apart from taking ample material education such as costing, taxation, accounting and 100 hrs mandatory computer training also helps student a lot to improve their skill in computer proficiency.

In final level, Students needs to go minimum 6 months of practical training before appearing for final examination which is very convenient in compare to other professional courses although completion of 3years of practical training is must to become member of the Institute. Proper practical training is very helpful for the students as it give opportunity to the students to apply the practical approach of whatever we learnt

during the course just after passing the intermediate exam.

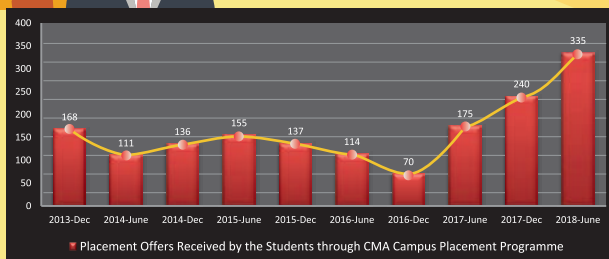
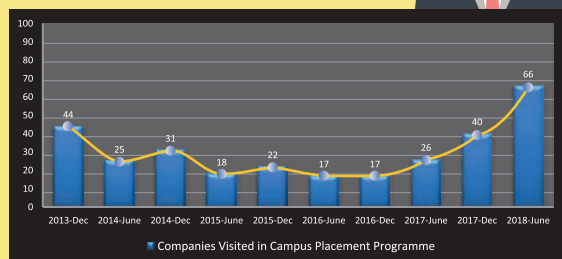

Term wise Campus Placement Record at a Glance (Dec-2013 to June-2018)

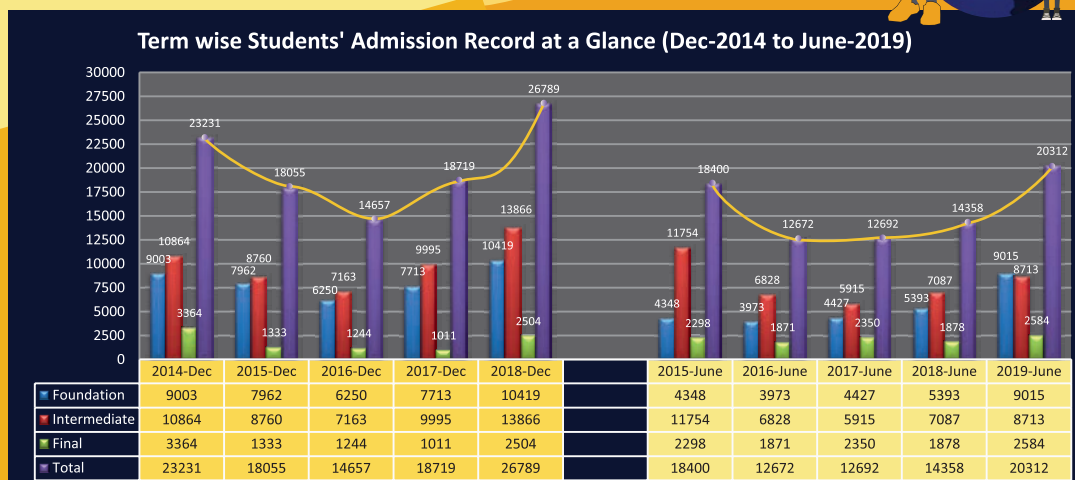
