## SAP Finance User Course: SAP Enable Now Cloud Portal - Course Navigation Guide

### Settings and Requirements

A few changes are required to the settings in your browser so that it will work perfectly with this Portal. Independent from your preferred browser the playback functionalities require following settings:

Requirement	Why?
Enabled Javascript	All functionalities are based on the use of Javascript. You must enable it if it is disabled.
Deactivated Pop-up blocker	No matter which Pop-up blocker you use, <b>you must DISABLE the blocking of Pop-ups for the SAP Cloud Portal</b> and location you are loading your contents from.
Activated cookies	The attributes and settings for displaying and executing <b>Book Reader</b> and <b>Library etc</b> are stored in cookies. Therefore You should activate cookies in your browser to ensure that these functionalities run accurately.

***Tip:** In case it happens that Flash contents are not displayed correctly, please uninstall and reinstall the Flash Plugin (Only update may not work).*

### Browser Requirements

The following requirements are to be considered to ensure an error-free use of the Trainer, Library and Book Reader functionalities, thus ensuring that contents are played back successfully.

**Note:** The playback on mobile devices is mainly supported for tablets.



## NAVIGATION

1. Open the SAP Enable Now Cloud Portal through the URL link given below:

You will see the following screen:




**(Please refer to the official SAP course registration mail sent you by ICAI or SAP for your User Id and Password)**

**ENTER** your **User Id** in the Username field

**ENTER** your **Password** in the Password field (*Note: This is case sensitive field*)

2. On FIRST time login or On the Password Expiry (as per SAP/ICAI Password Policy) you will be asked to change the password





3. On next step you will be asked for your consent and acceptance to the **Data protection and Privacy Statement and Terms**



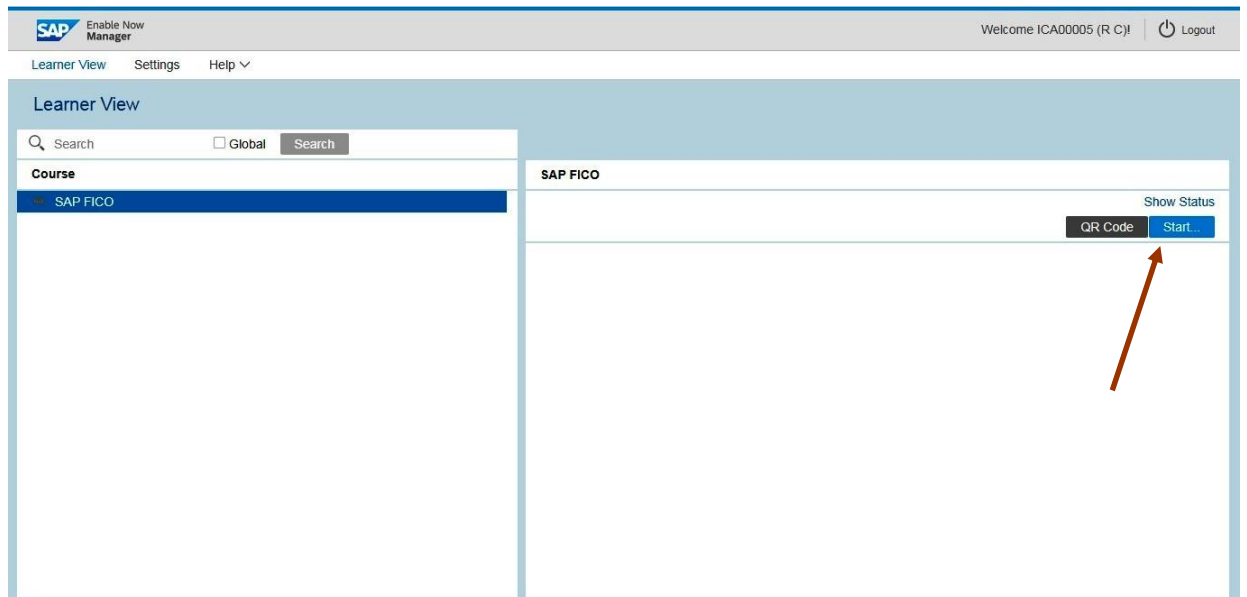

4. After successful Login, you will see the **Learner View** screen



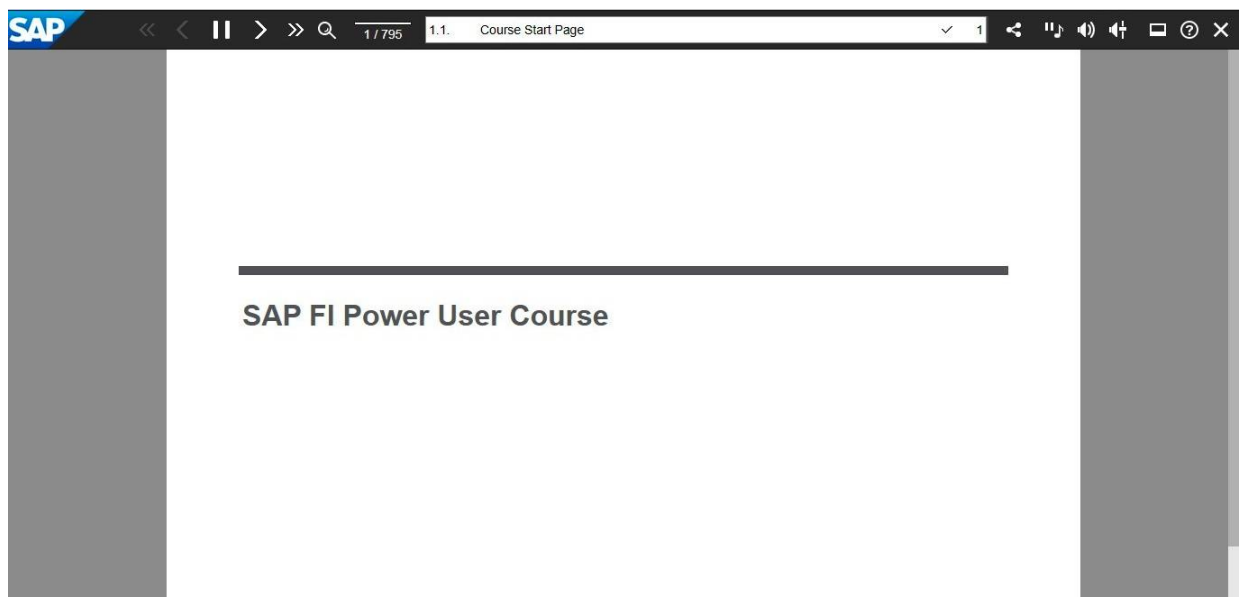
On the Right panel, in the course section, you can see the Course you are enrolled in.

To Start Course navigation please **Click on** the “**Start**” Button / Link.

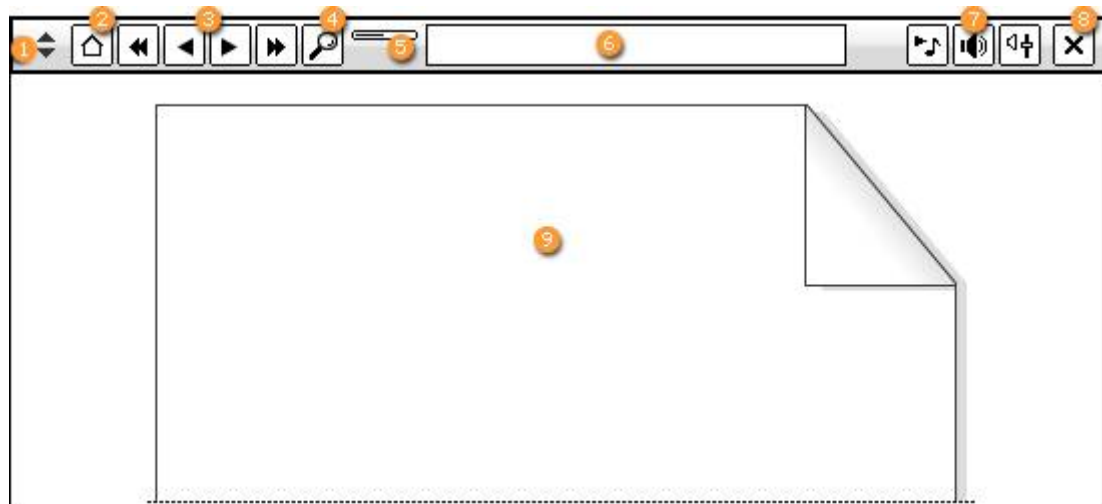
5. The **Course Screen (Book Reader)** will Pop-up (Open) in a **NEW TAB** in browser

*Note: Please make sure to **UNBLOCK** the Pop-ups for SAP and SAP Cloud Platform*



## 6. Course Screen (**Book Reader**) Architecture and Components

The **Book Reader** comprises the control bar and window for displaying the book page.



- **Orientation**

This function allows the position of the **Book Reader** bar to be manipulated.

- **Start page**

If a book page is defined as the start page then you can call it directly using the *Start page* button. For example, the book page can contain introductory information or a table of contents.

The button makes it easier for you to reach the start page directly at any time without having to resort to the book page selection.

- **Buttons for scrolling within the book pages**

The buttons allow you to scroll within the book pages. This is how you go forward or backward one book page at a time as well as how you use the external buttons to switch between chapters.

- **Keyword search**

This button opens a dialog in which you can search the book's book pages for a specific book page.

- **Progress display**

The progress display shows how many pages in a book have already been worked through. Moving the cursor over the progress display with the mouse shows you the number of book pages and current book page number.

- **Book page selection**

The book pages contained in the book can be selected by means of a dropdown list box, which displays an overview of the book pages. If the dropdown list box is closed, you can see the title of the chosen book page.

- **Audio Controls**  
**Play/Stop Audio**

Using this button allows you to start and stop background music or an audio commentary on a book page.

- On/Off Audio**

This button allows you to activate and deactivate the page sound for a book.

- Volume**

This function allows you to control or deactivate audio file volume and bubble effects.

Clicking on the button opens a selection menu from which the volume can be controlled and the sound deactivated by means of a selection field.

- **Close**

The *Close* button is used to close the **Book Reader**

- **Window for displaying the book page:**

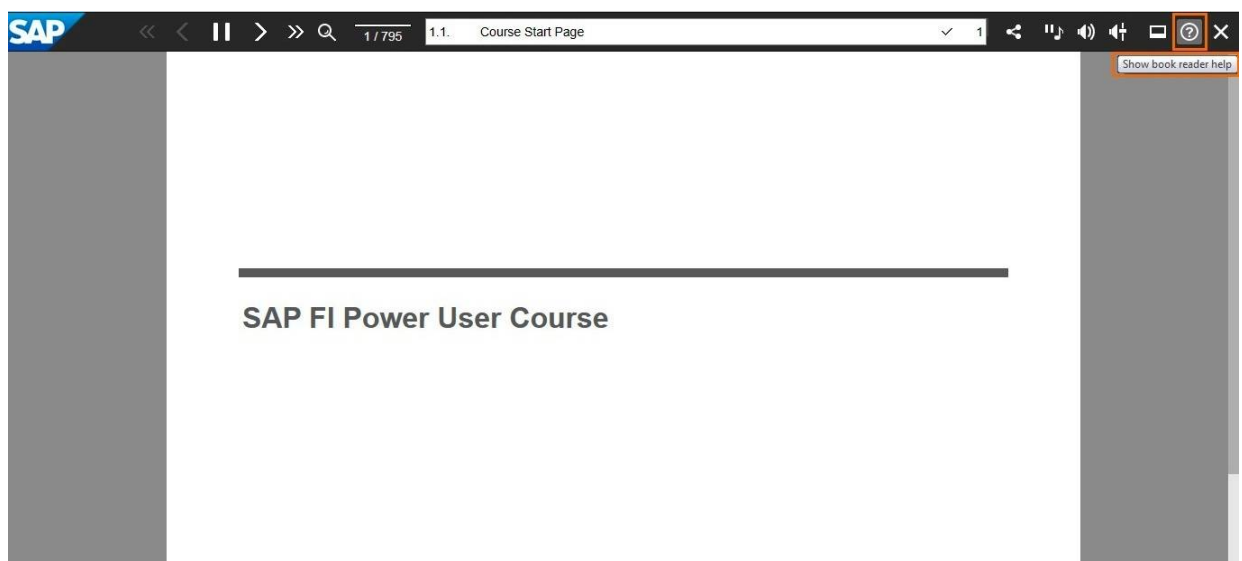
The chosen book page is displayed below the **Book Reader** control bar. You can now open the modes or documents, view a media file or work through some more content.

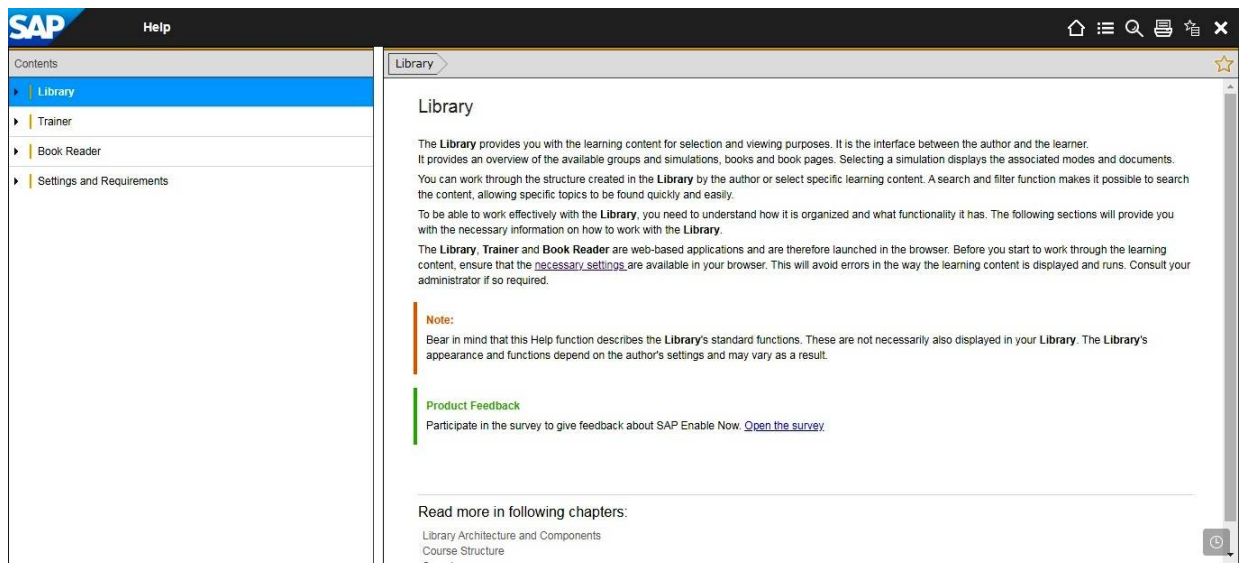

## 7. Book Reader Help

You can click the '?' button (*On the Top-Left side of the Book Reader screen*) to take Help and guidance for the Navigation and using the book reader.

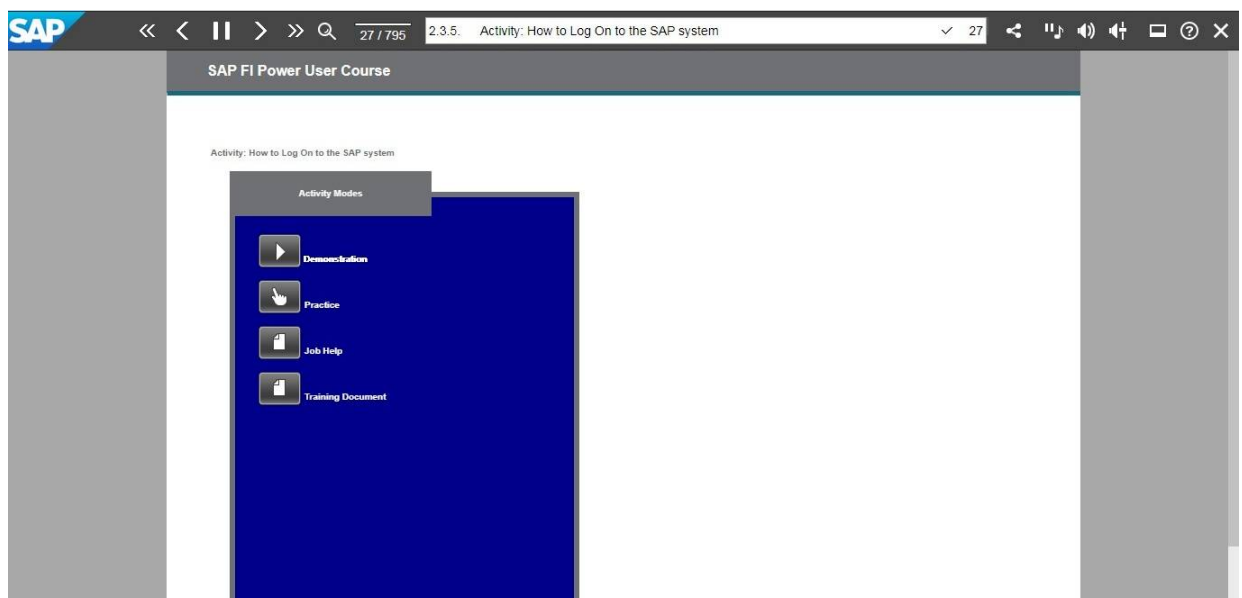

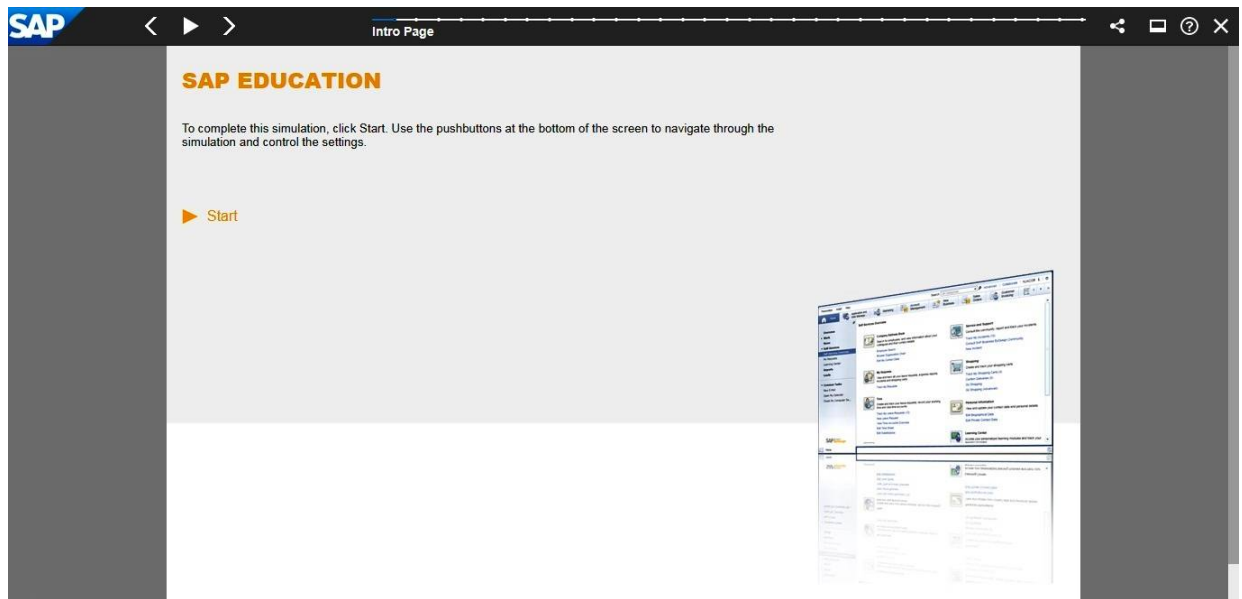

You will see the SAP System/Process screen/page of the Demonstration.

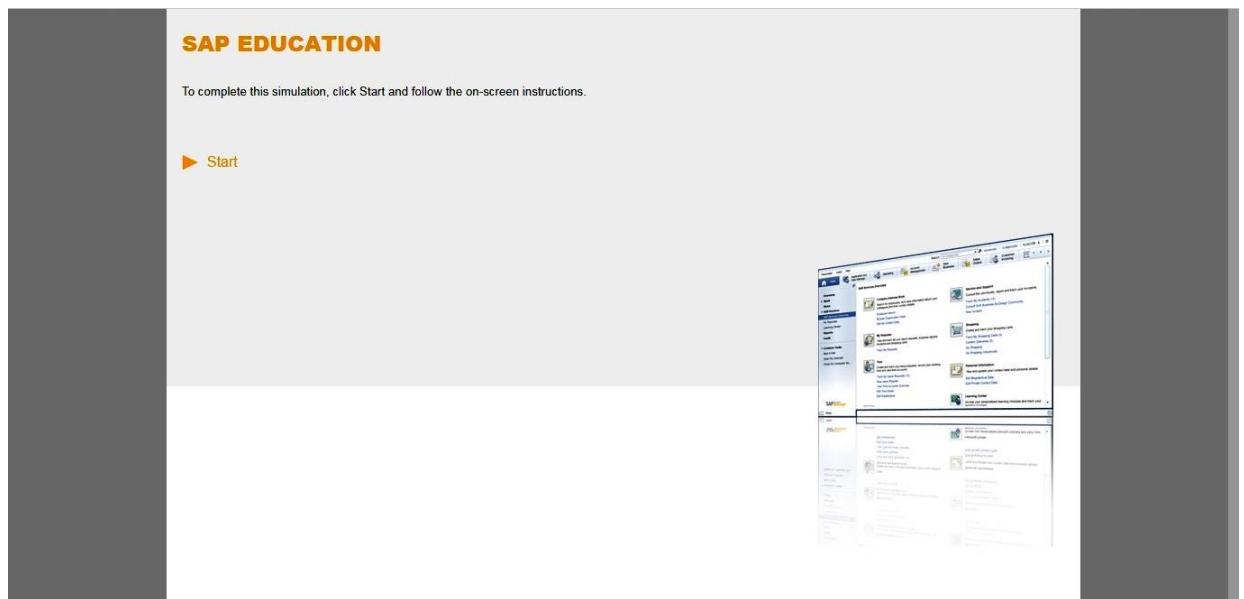

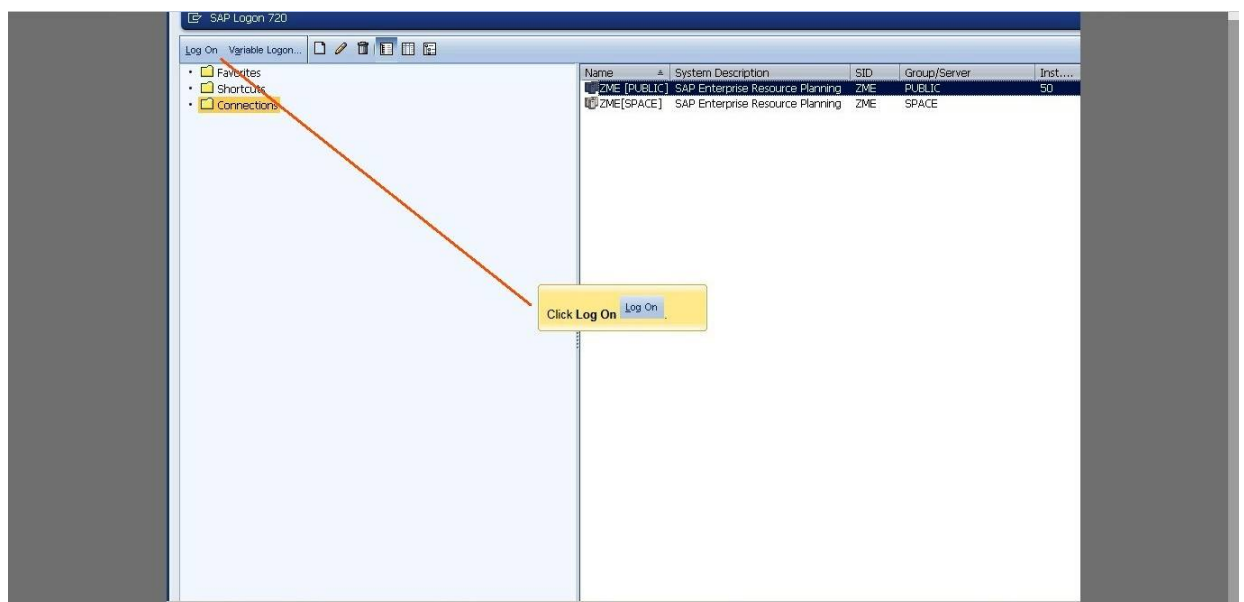

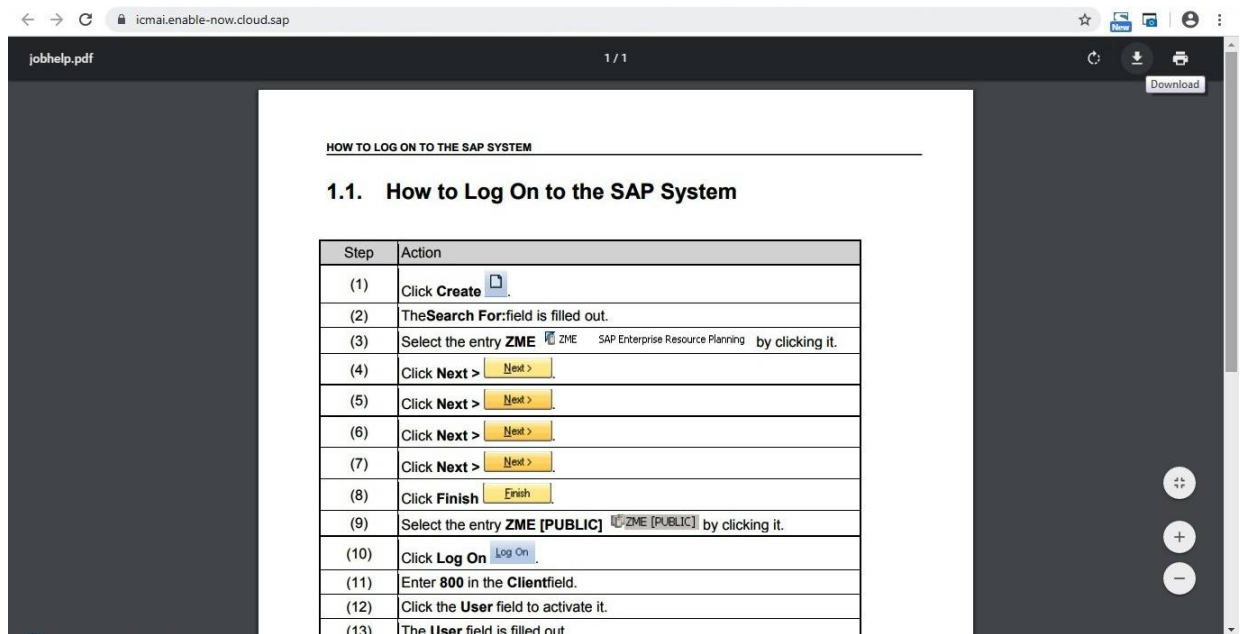

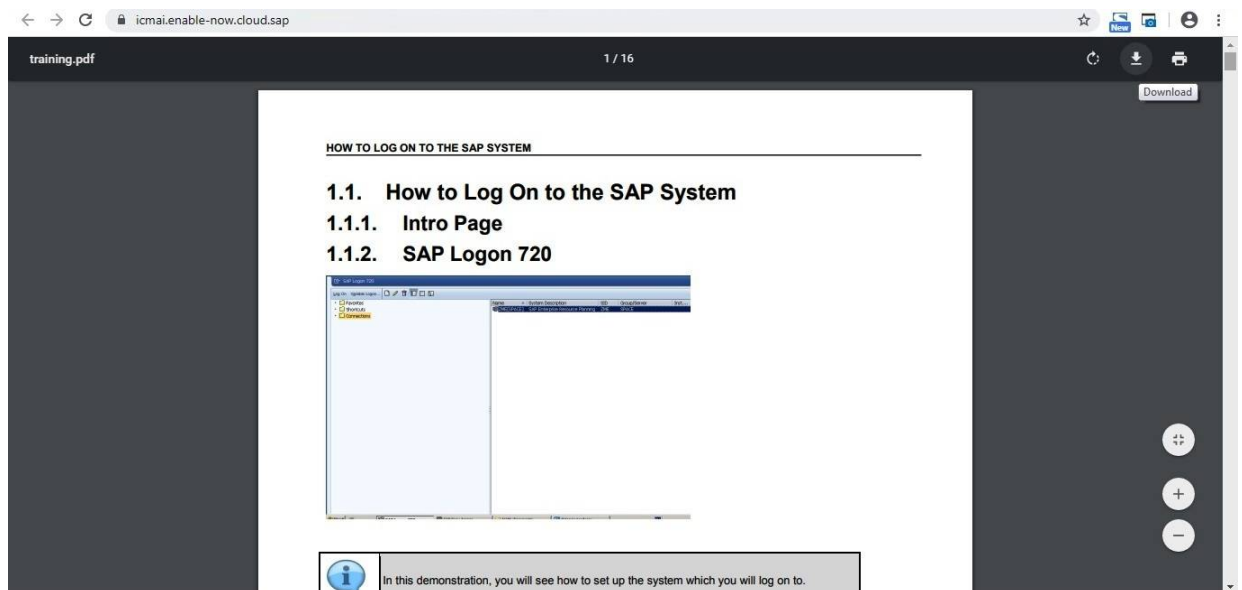

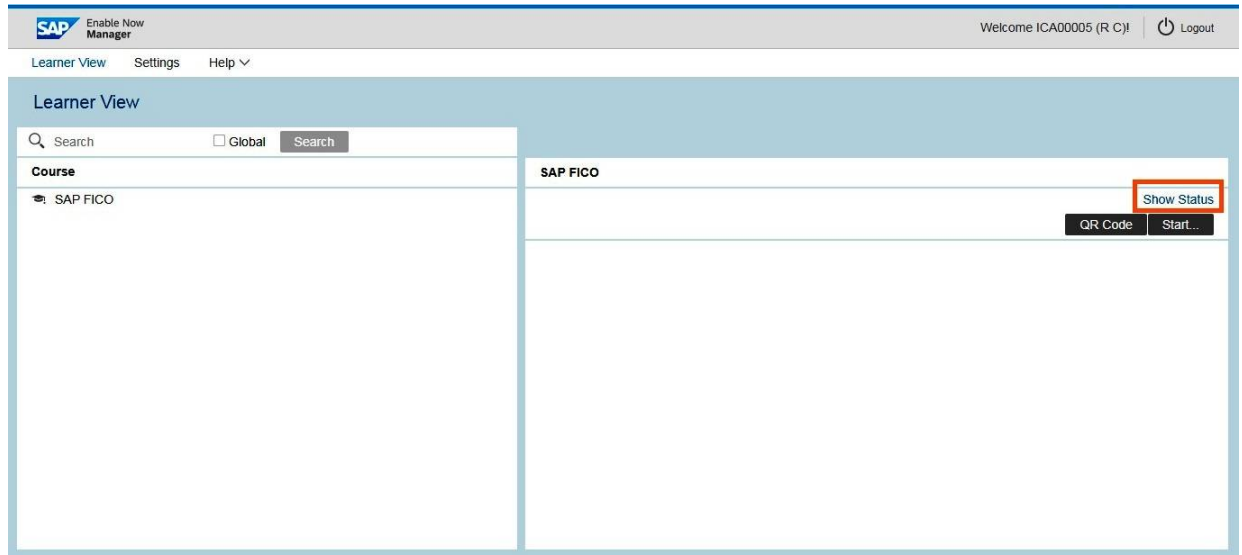

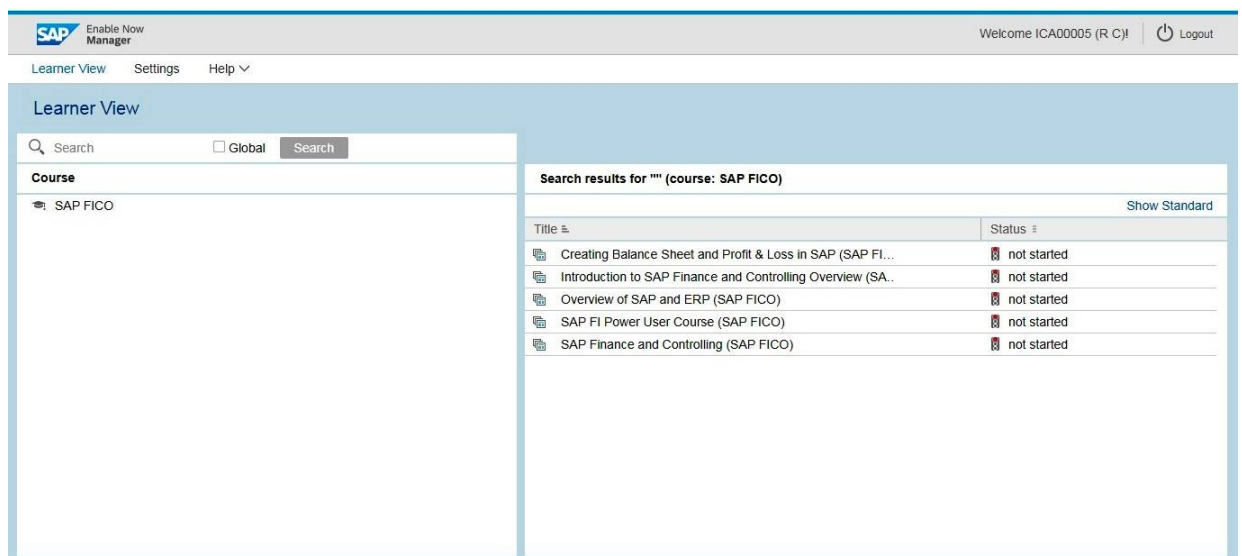
