6thCMA Awards-2019 CMA-CFO Awards, CMA Achiever Awards& CMA -Young Achiever Awards

CMA Awards recognize the significant contributions of CMAs in improving corporate governance, value creation and preservation, managing risk and control, achieving operational efficiency, promoting good CSR practices, and implementing innovative Cost and Management Accounting practices in order to propagate Cost Management culture to make Indian Industry cost competitive and sustainable. CMA Awards also recognise the outstanding Contribution of CMAs for CMA profession, Institute and society.

THE AWARD PROCESS

The Award process consists of the following three stages:

Stage 1: Inviting Nominations

Nominations are invited from **CMAs in employment** and not holding Certificate of Practice for the last three years. A CMA may nominate himself or any other CMA working in the same organization. A Senior Executive may also nominate one or more CMAs reporting to him. Nominations are invited for the below mentioned categories:

a) Each category of the award is further sub divided into Mega, Large, Medium, Small and Micro on the basis of turnover of the organization. (Base Year of Turnover is 2018-19)

Category	Parameters
Mega	More than Rs. 10,000 Crore
Large	Less than Rs 10,000 Crore & More than or equal to Rs. 4,000 Crore
Medium	Less than 4,000 Crore & More than or equal to Rs. 500 Crore
Small	Less than Rs. 500 Crore & More than or equal to Rs. 100 Crore
Micro	Less than Rs. 100 Crore

b) Woman – CMAs Categories: This shall be a category within each of the above categories and nomination of woman CMA shall be considered for these categories.

Stage 2: Short Listing by Screening Committee

Nominations received will be shortlisted for the CMA Awards based on the evaluation parameters/ criteria as fixed by the Screening Committee.

Shortlisted nominations in each category shall be placed before the Jury for final selection. The shortlisted candidates may be required to appear for personal interview. Further, the information furnished in 'Nomination Form' can also be verified from the concerned organization(s).

Stage 3: Final Selection by the Jury*

The Jury shall consider the parameters/criteria as fixed by the Screening Committee for short-listing the candidates. The Jury may also use any other criteria as it deems fit. The Jury shall decide the Awardees in each category and the decision of the Jury in this regard shall be final. Jury shall have over riding power to decide on the basis of other credentials and performance.

***Jury:** The Jury will consist of eminent personalities viz. members from Judiciary, leading Management Consultant, representatives of Industry associations and Chambers, Regulators, Academicians, Professionals and others.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

- 1. CFO who is a Key Managerial Person (KMP) of an organization shall be eligible for nomination in 'CMA-CFO Awards'.
- 2. CMAs not eligible under serial number 1 above shall be eligible for nomination in 'CMA-Achiever Awards' are above 35 years of age.
- 3. CMAs not eligible under serial number 1&2 above and are 35 years or below age shall be eligible for nomination in 'CMA-Young Achiever Awards'.
- 4. CMA, who got the award from the Institute in the past in a category, shall not be eligible for nomination in the same category for next three years.
- 5. Nominations of the same person in different categories/sub categories will not be considered.
- The person retired/applied for COP/changed the organization between the date of submission of application and Award ceremony will not be presented the award. Hence, the nominee or nominator must withdraw his nomination form immediately after such instance.
- 7. Members holding positions in the Managing Committee of a Regional Council/Council are not eligible to participate.
- 8. Membership fee should be paid up to 2019-20 else application will be rejected.
- 9. Nomination form should be submitted through their respective reporting officer.

General Guidelines:

- 1. The information asked in the Nomination Form should be filled-in with correct and complete details.
- 2. Screening Committee reserves the right to reject any nomination without assigning any reasons therefore.
