A swachh drive begins at Delhi station to mark 100 years of Mahatma's return

NEW DELHI: To commemorate 100 years of Mahatma Gandhi's return to India from South Africa, a joint cleanliness drive was launched by Imagindia Institute and the Japanese community in India on Thursday.
