ICAI president meets Rural Development Min

President of the Institute of Cost Accountants of India (ICAI) Rakesh Singh met state Rural Development Minister Arvind Kumar Singh Gope.

Singh spoke about the role of Cost and Management Accountants toward development of the state as well as rural areas.
