Three officials surrendered before police in Treasury scam

Three government officials who were allegedly siphoned off government funds to the tune of Rs.5.3 crore by submitting fake bills in the Chintapalli Sub treasury scam surrendered before the police. The SP (Rural) Koya Praveen said that Appala Raju, senior assistant of sub-treasury of Chintapalli, S Simhachalam, senior assistant at RCD Hospital and P Sanjeeva Rao, senior assistant at additional DMHO office Paderu voluntarily surrendered before the investigation officer on January 28. They were arrested and produced before the court in Chintapalli.

TTD scraps VIP break darshan on Thursday evenings

TIRUMALA: The TTD Executive Officer D Sambasiva Rao said that there would be no VIP break darshan on Thursday evenings making the management in clearing 10,000 pilgrims more. TTD management is contemplating introducing a new version of Nitya Annadanam scheme for the benefit of the devotees. Under this scheme, a donor will be entitled to contribute sufficient amount so as to enable the TTD feed an individual on permanent basis, he said.

Consensus not necessary for Special Status for the State

RAJAHMUNDRY: Breaking a long silence, former Rajahmundry MP Vundavalli Arun Kumar addressing his first media conference after the elections urged the Prime Minister Narendra Modi government to keep its promise of granting special status to the State and release advance amount of at least Rs.10,000 crore. He said that the State was facing severe financial crises and was not in a position to pay salaries to the staff. Referring to the media reports on the special status, he said that for granting special status, consensus among the States was not necessary. He reminded that the last Cabinet meeting of Manmohan Singh Government that special status would be given to the State and Planning commission would be asked to take necessary steps in this direction, he said.
