1. Bids are invited from the ISPs as per qualification criteria given in the Tender Document for Internet Leased Line of capacity 50 Mbps (1:1) with 05 nos. useable WAN IP for a period of one year as per scope defined in the Tender Document.
2. **Submission of Tender:** Quotation signed by the bidder in a sealed envelope, superscribed with “Tender for Internet Leased Line of capacity 50 Mbps (1:1) is to be submitted on or before 3.30 p.m. of **July 20, 2022 till 3:30 P.M.** in the Tender Box of the Institute at the following address :

4. The quotation must be valid for minimum 90 days from the date of submission of quotations.
5. The Institute is not bound to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to cancel any or all the Tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

Chapter – 2: Instructions to Bidders

Pre-qualification criteria for the Bidders

The Eligible bidder should satisfy the below mentioned criteria and should submit valid Documentary evidence for the below mentioned points:

1. Quotations will be accepted only from Telecom Companies (Like Airtel, Jio, Vodafone etc.) who are purely ISP, not reseller, who have valid ISP license from Govt. of India (Attach a copy of Certificate).
2. Number of connections to be procured – 02
3. The Bidder (ISP) should be a company registered in India under Registrar of companies (Attach a copy of Certificate).
4. The Bidder (ISP) must be capable of delivering the internet protocol i.e. IPv4 as per the guidelines of Govt. of India.
5. The Bidder (ISP) shall provide all the necessary hardware equipment for providing the Internet connectivity.
6. The Bidder (ISP) must provide entire connectivity up to the Router/Firewall level located at the customer premises.
7. The last mile connectivity shall be in Fiber.
8. The bidder should have an average turnover of INR.1000 crores or above during audited financial years 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 and submit the copy of the audited annual accounts for these years along with the copy of PAN No and GSTIN No.
9. The bidder should have executed (during last 3 years) at least two projects for implementation of internet bandwidth of capacity 50 Mbps or more. Detail of such projects and references to be provided.

General Instructions

1. **Taxes:** The percentage of all the taxes, duties, levies, must be quoted in clear terms separately. If the taxes are not mentioned separately, it will be presumed that the rates quoted are inclusive of all taxes.

2. **Delivery:** Preferably immediate. In case there is any specific schedule of delivery on the part of bidder, it should be clearly mentioned.
3. The contract period for leased line would initially be for a period of one year. It may be extended on yearly basis for four more times depending on satisfactory services and mutual agreement on the same terms and conditions and price.
4. In case there is a drop in the bandwidth charges, the vendor would pass on the benefits of reduced price (recurring charges) to the Institute or would offer increased bandwidth in lieu of reduction in the prices.
5. Any bid received after the last date & time for receipt of the given in the Tender Document will be rejected.
6. The quoted rates of offer will be valid for a period of 90 days.
7. Work order will be communicated to successful bidder by email.
8. Taxes shall be paid as applicable and quoted by the vendor.
9. The statutory tax deductions on the payment made by the Institute would be done as per the prevalent Tax laws of Government of India.
10. The bidder should sign each and every page of this document and attach it with the bid document.
11. The committee reserves the right to reject any/ all quotations without assigning any reason there for.

16. All disputes regarding interpretation of the contents of the Tender or its implementation shall be resolved by Mutual discussion/reconciliation in good faith by the party and The Institute of Cost Accountants of India.
17. This tender shall be governed by the laws of India for the time being in force and subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Courts at Delhi.
