Scheduled Tribe candidates who have passed the matriculation or higher secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education are eligible. The scholarships are available for the study of all recognized post matriculation or post-secondary courses in recognized institutions except certain identified training courses like Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Courses, Private Pilot Licence courses etc. The scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend. Students who have received coaching in any of the pre-examination training centres with financial assistance from the Government will not be eligible.</p>	<p>All the eligible Scheduled Tribes candidates will be given scholarships subject to the application of Means Test prescribed in these Regulations.</p>
