# STUDY NOTE/CHAPTER - 7: PAYMENT OF GRATUITY ACT, 1972 STUDY NOTE/CHAPTER - 9: EMPLOYEES STATE INSURANCE ACT, 1948

### > GRATIUTY

The maximum amount of gratuity now is ₹ 20 lakhs instead of ₹10 lakhs.

#### > CHANGES IN EMPLOYEES STATE INSURANCE ACT, 1948

- Employees must be registered online on the date of appointment; the online system shall allow maximum 10 days to register the new employee.
- Employee will have to collect their Biometric ESI Permanent Card from nearest Branch Office.
- Contribution against employee must be deposited within the due date. One shall not be able to deposit contribution online after 42 days from the end date of the contribution period.
  - Employee whose salary per day is ₹176/- or less need not to pay Employee's contribution and the same will be paid by the Govt. However, Employer will have to pay their share of contribution.

#### Contribution have been reduced:

Employee Share	1.75	0.75
Total ESI Contribution	6.50	4.00

The wage ceiling of coverage was also enhanced from ₹ 15,000/- per month to ₹ 21,000/- per month.
