The Goods and Services Tax Network (“GSTN”) has enabled the feature to withdraw application for cancellation of GST registration on the GST portal.

If the application for cancellation of GST registration is made by mistake and the applicant wishes to withdraw the application, then that may be withdrawn so now by following below mentioned steps:

1. Go to the Common Portal and post login navigate through **Services** → **User Services** → **View My Submissions**
2. Click on the “**Withdraw**” button available beside your **Application for Cancellation of Registration**
3. Click on **Confirm** and your application will be **withdrawn**.
