**Notification No. 29/2022-Customs (ADD)**

Dated 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2022

The Central Government Seeks to impose Anti-Dumping duty on "Electrogalvanized Steel" originating in or exported from Korea RP, Japan and Singapore, for a period of 5 years, in pursuance of fresh final findings issued by DGTR

G.S.R. ---(E).-Whereas in the matter of 'Electrogalvanized Steel' (hereinafter referred to as the subject goods) falling under tariff heading 7209, 7210, 7211, 7212, 7225 and 7226 of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 (51 of 1975) (hereinafter referred to as the Customs Tariff Act), originating in, or exported from Korea RP, Japan and Singapore (hereinafter referred to as the subject countries), and imported into India, the designated authority in its final findings, vide notification No.6/7/2021-DGTR, dated the 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part I, Section 1, dated the 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, has come to the conclusion that—

- (i) the subject goods have been exported to India from the subject countries below normal values;
- (ii) the domestic industry has suffered material injury on account of subject imports from subject countries;
- (iii) the material injury has been caused by the dumped imports of subject goods from the subject countries and has recommended imposition of an anti-dumping duty on the imports of subject goods, originating in, or exported from the subject countries and imported into India, in order to remove injury to the domestic industry
