- The Examination form and Examination fees will be accepted through online mode only. No offline form and offline payment will be accepted under any circumstance.
- Last date of receipt of Examination Application form is 30th November, 2023. There will be no extension in the last date of receipt of examination application forms for January 2024 examination.**
- To fill the online examination form, students may visit the Institute's website www.icmai.in and pay examination fees Rs. 1000/- through payment gateway by using Credit/Debit card.
- A candidate/student who is completing all conditions for appearing in the examination as per Regulations will only be allowed to appear for the examination.
- Candidates/Students are requested to carefully check their details viz. spelling of their name or Father's name, date of birth, email id and mobile number while filling the examination form. For any change in the same candidates may inform CAT Directorate at catexam@icmai.in by the last date of receipt of Examination Application form, i.e. by 30th November, 2023. Any request for change in these details received after this date shall not be entertained and CAT Directorate shall not be held responsible for the wrong credentials of the candidate/student.
- Examination Pattern- The CAT Course Part-I Examination shall have Multiple Choice Questions to be answered online.
