- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in

the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

- 4. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
- 5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated online in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents. 6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 7. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -
- 1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
- 2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost: or
- 3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

#### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

#### 2. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

## 3. Service & Support

AVAILABILITY OF OFFICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER: An office of the Service Provider must be located in the state of Consignee. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE TO BE SUBMITTED.

## 4. Past Project Experience

**Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause:** For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause: For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with

self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.

#### 5. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

The empanelled CA will be required to work towards timely completion before the statutory dead line of following-

- 1. Submission of Return certificates of TDS (Income Tax) as per procedure laid down in IT Act, 1 961.
- 2. Submission of Return certificates of TDS (Goods and Services Tax) as per procedure laid dow n in

GST Act, 2017.

- 3. Filing of form 24Q, 26Q and other TDS form (if required) and also provide form 16 Part A a nd Part B and form 16A
- 4. Preparation of monthly challans of TDS and TDS on GST.
- 5. To process records of Income-Tax in respect of employees and Third parties of ESIC SRO, Luck now.
- 6. To filing and processing of records of TDS in respect of Third Parties. Quarterly and Yearly return to Income-Tax Department.
- 7. Generation of GST challan on monthly basis.
- 8. Submission and filing of monthly/quarterly/yearly returns to GST Department as per rules amended from time to time.
- 9. To provide professional advice in financial matters, if required by ESIC SRO Lucknow.
- 10. The successful contractor shall sign an agreement with ESIC with standard terms and conditions for providing professional services of Chartered Accountant.
- 11. The Contractor (CA) or his representative will have to appear before competent authority as an d when required due to exigency of Income Tax related work.
- 12. The assigned work shall be undertaken under the supervision of the engaged firm and this office shall only be responsible for providing related documents when called for.
- 13. The engaged firm will be responsible for any corrections arising out of their own faults at no further cost to this office.
- 14. The Responsibility of correctness and accuracy of the details collected from the records of ESI C Sub Regional Office will lie with the Contractor / Firm.
- 15.A reasonable penalty may be imposed on the Contractor / Firm by ESIC Sub Regional Office as decided, if it is found that the Contractor / Firm failed to perform its obligations in any manner. Su ch penalty may be deducted from the payment to be made to the Contractor / Firm after giving a written notice.
- 16. Contractor / Firm will maintain high standards of integrity and professional ethics and morality while handling the work of ESIC Sub Regional Office and dealing with ESIC Sub Regional Office and its officials. If it is found that this condition of confidentiality is compromised by the Contractor / Firm, then ESIC Sub Regional Office will be at liberty to take further steps (e.g., requesting ICAI for c

ancellation of license) against the Contractor / Firm.

- 17. ESIC Regional Office is a Government office and hence, the accounting records and information related to ESIC Sub Regional Office shall be handled by the Contractor / Firm in a confidential manner and must not be shared with any outsider.
- 18. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, ESIC Sub Regional Office reserves the right to discontinue the services of the Contractor / Firm in the event their services are evaluated as unsatisfactory at a ny time during the period.
- 19. Any losses sustained by ESIC Sub Regional Office due to negligence of Contractor/Firm's services in the form of any loss/damage of property (including those attributable to individual employees/manpower engaged by the Contractor/Firm) will be recoverable from the Contractor/Firm, as the money value shall be est imated by ESIC Sub Regional Office. The decision of ESIC Sub Regional Office in this regard will be final and binding on the Contractor/Firm.
- 20. The engaged Firm shall provide full details of their representative with qualification etc. Such represent ative will carry identity card of the firm during visit to this office and shall maintain the decorum of the office.
- 21. The personnel deployed shall be healthy, active and individuals of high integrity. Nobody shall have an y communicable diseases.
- 22. The Contractor / Firm shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or subcontract its rights and liabilities under this contract to any other agency.
- 23. Service charge/consultancy charge or any other charges will not be paid separately for any of the services mentioned in scope of work.
- 24. The CA firm shall bear all expenses regarding compensations, wages and allowances (DA), PF, ESI, Bon us and Gratuity as applicable relating to personnel engaged by him and abide by the provisions of various I abor legislations. Payment to the firm shall be made on basis on submission of bill by the firm and on rend ering satisfactory service by the firm.
- 25. In case of death or mishap leading to any injury or disability whatsoever, occurred during discharging the duty, the compensation /legal or any other liability will solely rest with the CA firm.
- 26. That CA firm's authorized representative (Owner/Director/Partner/Manager) shall personally contact th e DDO / Head of Office at least once a month to get a feedback on the services rendered by the Contractor vis-a-vis corrective action required to make the services more efficient.
- 27. The Contractor or his representatives shall visit ESIC Sub Regional Office during the working hours of E SIC Sub Regional Office will be as under: 9:00 AM to 5.30 PM from Monday to Friday. Saturday and Sunday are holiday on account of being weekend days.
- 28. In the event of person deputed by CA firm being on leave/absent, the CA firm shall ensure suitable alte rnative arrangement to make up for such absence.
- 29. If any of the personnel of the contractor indulges in theft or any illegal/irregular activities, misconduct, the contractor will take appropriate action as per law and rules against its erring personnel in consultation with this office and intimate the action taken to this office. If need be, an FIR should be lodged against the erring personnel. Such personnel, who indulge in such type of activities, should not be further employed in this office by the contractor in any case.
- 30. During the period of contract, the rates will be revised with the revision of any taxes by the Governmen t of India.
- 31. This Contract may be terminated at any time if the work is not satisfactory.
- 32. **Payment Procedure:** Payment shall be made on quarterly basis on the production of the bill to this o ffice. No other payment besides the one mentioned for the services in the work order shall be made.
- 33. **Breach of Contract**: In case of breach of any terms and conditions attached to the contract, t he Performance Security Deposit of the Contractor will be liable to be forfeited by ESIC besides annulment of the contract.
- 34. Period of Contract: The Contract shall initially be valid for a period of two years and may be

extended further for a period of one year subject to satisfactory performance, on the same terms and conditions and on mutual consent. The rates quoted shall remain same during the entire period of the contract. ESIC, however, reserves the right to terminate the contract by serving.

- 35. **Force Majeure:** ESIC may consider relaxing the requirements, as specified in this document, if and to the extent that, the performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an Force Majeure. Force Majeure is defined as an event of effect that cannot reasonably be anticipated s uch as acts of God (like earthquakes, floods, storms etc.), acts of states / state agencies, the direct and ind irect consequences of wars (declared or undeclared), hostilities, national emergencies, civil commotion and strikes at successful Bidder's premises or any other act beyond control of the bidder.
- 36. **Dispute Settlement:** It is mutually agreed that all differences and disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be settled by mutual discussions and negotiations if such disputes and differences cannot be settled and resolved by discussions and negotiations then the same shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator appointed by the DG, ESIC whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- 37. The tenderer shall indemnify the Centre against all other damages/charges and expenses for which thi s Centre may be held liable or pay on account of the negligence of the tenderer or his staff or any person under his control whether in respect of accident, injury to the person or damage to the property of any me mber of the public or any person or in executing the work or otherwise and against all claims and demand thereof. The Board shall not be responsible financially or otherwise for any injury to the worker or person deployed by the tenderer during the course of performing duties.
- 38. <u>Jurisdiction:</u> The disputes, legal matters, court matters, if any shall be subject to Lucknow, Uttar Prad esh, India jurisdiction only.
- 39. Minor variations in the terms and conditions of the contract as specified can be adopted with the concurrence of both the parties wherever required to fulfill the objectives of the contract.
- 40. Canvassing in connection with tender is strictly prohibited. No enquiry shall be made by the bidder(s) d uring the course of evaluation of the tender, till final decision is conveyed to the successful bidder.
- 41. ESIC is a statutory autonomous body under Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India and accord ingly all notifications order/guidelines of govt of India/ESIC as applicable, shall also be a part of this tender /Contract.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.

- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.

This Bid is governed by the <u>General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्तें</u>, conditions stipulated in Bid and <u>Service Level Agreement</u> specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्तें is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
