A Technical Criteria:

A.1 (i) Bidder must have executed at least three (03) contracts, each of minimum executed value of Rs. 5.87 Lacs for an Internal Audit job in any of the previous 7 years reckoned from bid due date for a company having a minimum turnover of **Rs. 750 Crores** during that period engaged in City Gas Distribution/Oil & Gas/Petrochemical/Fertiliser/ Refinery/ Power / Mining / Process Industry.

OR

(ii) Bidder must have executed at least two (02) contracts, each of minimum executed value of Rs. 7.33 Lacs for an Internal Audit job in any of the previous 7 years reckoned from bid due date for a company having a minimum turnover of **Rs. 750 Crores** during that period engaged in City Gas Distribution/Oil & Gas/Petrochemical/Fertiliser/ Refinery/ Power / Mining / Process Industry.

OR

- (iii) Bidder must have executed at least a single contract of minimum executed value of Rs. 11.73 Lacs for an Internal Audit job in any of the previous 7 years reckoned from bid due date for a company having a minimum turnover of **Rs.** 750 Crores during that period engaged in City Gas Distribution/Oil & Gas/Petrochemical/Fertiliser/ Refinery/ Power / Mining / Process Industry.
- A.2 In case the bidder does not have experience as mentioned at sl. no. A.1 (i to iii), bidder can submit their bid on the basis of technical experience of foreign based another company (supporting company) besides complying to the conditions mentioned at clause no. D below.
 - The foreign based supporting company also to meet other criteria(s) as mentioned above at sl. no. A.1 (i & iii) or the criteria at sl. no. A.3 as applicable.
- A.3 In case the bidder is executing a rate contract of above which is still running and the contract executed value till one day prior to the due date of bid submission is equal to or more than the minimum prescribed value as mentioned above, such experience will also be taken into consideration provided that the bidder has to submit satisfactory work execution certificate to this effect issued by the end user / owner / authorized consultant.

A.4 A job executed by a bidder for its own plant / projects cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting requirement of BEC of the tender. However, jobs executed for Subsidiary / Fellow subsidiary / Holding company will be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BEC subject to submission of tax paid invoice(s) duly certified by Statutory Auditor of the bidder towards payments of statutory tax in support of the job executed for Subsidiary /Fellow subsidiary / Holding company. Such bidders to submit these documents in addition to the documents specified in the bidding documents to meet BEC.

Notes to BEC-Technical:

- (i) Experience acquired by a bidder as a sub-contractor can be accepted against submission of requisite certificate / documents from end user by such bidder along with other specified documents.
- (ii) Bids of Joint Venture / Consortium will not be acceptable.
- (iii) In case bidder has executed multiple order/contracts under a rate contract/agreement, all executed orders/contracts shall be considered as single order/contract for evaluation of credentials of a bidder for meeting the experience criteria as mentioned above.

H BID EVALUATION METHODOLOGY FOR AWARD:

The evaluation of bids will be made on following basis:

- i. GAIL Gas Ltd. will evaluate and compare the bids of the techno-commercially qualified bidders whose bids are previously determined to be substantially responsive pursuant to "ITB: Clause-29".
- ii. Techno-commercial Evaluation of the bids will be done first against the BEC stipulated in relevant Section of the tender document to qualify the bidders.
- iii. The Bids of the qualified bidder(s) shall be further assessed as per the Bid Assessment Criteria/Bid Evaluation Methodology as under:

I Methodology of Technical Evaluation (Evaluation of Quality):

- i. GAIL Gas Limited shall evaluate each technical proposal considering the criteria like relevant experience for the assignment, qualification of the key staff, Financial competency, Location preference etc.
- ii. A minimum qualifying mark on technical points to be scored is 68 (i.e. out of maximum 100 marks) for opening of the price bid.
- iii. The technical evaluation of the proposal shall be done on the basis of Evaluation of Quality and the aggregate score less than the minimum qualifying marks i.e. 68 (i.e. out of maximum 100 marks) will be disqualified.

J. EVALUATION AND AWARD METHODOLOGY:

- (i) Only techno-commercially qualified bidders and the bidder securing minimum 68 Marks against the Technical Points (Evaluation of Quality, mentioned at clause no. I) shall be considered for price bid opening. Price Bids shall be evaluated based on overall cost to GAIL Gas Limited including applicable GST (CGST & SGST/UTGST or IGST). Contract will be awarded to the bidder who has secured highest total score combining technical and financial score as stipulated under "COMBINED QUALITY AND COST EVALUATION".
- (ii) The bidder shall quote as percentage (plus OR minus) over Total Estimated Cost (inclusive of GST) as indicated in the SOR, Section-VII of tender document. The quoted plus (+) percentage shall be added on Total Estimated Cost (inclusive of GST) and quoted minus (-) percentage shall be deducted from Total Estimated Cost (inclusive of GST), for evaluation. The Bidder's quoted amount shall be based on complete Scope of Work and other terms & conditions mentioned in tender document and its amendment (if any).
- (iii) In case, any techno-commercially qualified bidders quote beyond plus OR

minus 5% over Total Estimated Cost (inclusive of GST), their price bid will not be considered for further evaluation and will be disqualified.

(iv) COMBINED QUALITY AND COST EVALUATION

Contract will be awarded to the bidder who has secured highest total score combining technical and financial score. For this purpose, 80% weightage is assigned to Evaluation of Quality, mentioned at clause no. I above and 20% weightage is assigned to cost part, i.e. SOR, Section-VII of tender document.

Since the tender is being floated through GeM portal therefore, QCBS formula available on GeM portal shall be applicable as under:

Where

C = Evaluated Bid price

Clow = The lowest of all evaluated Bid price among responsive Bids

X = Weightage for the process as specified in Bids i.e. 0.20 in this case

(v) In case more than one bidder is tied up at one position, contract will be awarded to the bidder who has secured more score against the Technical Evaluation (Evaluation of Quality, mentioned at clause no. I)). In case of further tie in the score against the Technical Evaluation (Evaluation of Quality), then, contract will be awarded to the bidder, whose turnover during last audited financial statement is higher.

Note 1:

- 1) In case, any unregistered bidder [i.e. not registered with statutory authority for GST] is submitting their bid, their prices will be loaded with applicable GST (CGST&SGST/UTGST or IGST) during evaluation of bid.
- 2) In case any cess on GST is applicable, the same shall also be considered in evaluation.
- 2.3.4 The conditions for availing purchase preference as per PPP-2012 (Public Procurement Policy for MSEs-2012) & PPP-MII (Make In India) like bidder's price in the specified price band, bidder agreeing to match L1 Price, etc. shall be applicable as given in the tender under relevant clauses.
