The Mission Director, National Health Mission, Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal is going for e-tender for selection and empanelment of Concurrent Auditors under National Health Mission for West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti for the F.Y.-2024-25 and onward.

# **General Instructions:**

- Any bidder willing to take part in the process of e-tendering will have to be enrolled and registered
  with the Government e-procurement system; through logging on to https://wbtenders.gov.in
  using the option "Click here to Enroll". Possession of a valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) in
  the form of smart card /e-token is a prerequisite for registration and participation in the bid
  submission activities through this website. Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) can be obtained from
  the authorized certifying agencies, details of which are available in the website
  https://wbtenders.gov.in under the link Information about DSC.
- Intending bidder may download the tender documents free of cost from the website: https://wbtenders.gov.in directly with the help of Digital Signature Certificate or from the Health & Family Welfare Department's website www.wbhealth.gov.in.
- Both Technical bid and Financial Bid are to be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed by the
  authorized partner of bidding firm in the website https:// wbtenders.gov.in. All papers must be
  submitted in English language with unique page number in all documents.
- 4. The FINANCIAL BID of the prospective bidder will be opened only if the TECHNICAL BID of the bidder is found qualified by the Authority. The decision of the Authority shall be final and binding in this respect. The name of Qualified Bidder will be displayed in the website.
- EMD: The bidder has to deposit earnest money of Rs.35,000/- (Rupees thirty five thousand only) online. Bid shall be accompanied by photo copy of payment of earnest money deposit.
- The Earnest Money of all the unsuccessful bidders, deposited online, shall be refunded in accordance with the Memorandum of the Finance Department issued in this regard.



7. The Earnest Money may be forfeited if; -

i ) If the Bidder withdraws the Bid during the period of Bid validity.

ii) In case of successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails to execute formal agreement within the stipulated

time period.

iii) During scrutiny, if it is come to the notice of tender inviting authority that the credential or any other document which were uploaded & digitally signed by the Bidder are incorrect /manufactured / fabricated.

- 8. Audit firms eligible for apply: CA Firm and CMA Firm may only apply for empanelment under this tender. In case of CA Firm who are empanelled with C&AG for the FY 2024-25 may apply for empanelment under this tender. In case of CMA Firm who have completed incorporation for 5 year at the date of issue of this NIT, may apply for empanelment under this tender.
- Empanelled Audit Firm through this tender may also be engaged for special audit or other professional work of if required during the valid period of empanelment.
- The empanelment will initially be valid for 03 (years) w.e.f the F.Y. 2024-25. It may be extended for further period if desired by the authority.
- 11. This NIT has been issued only for empanelment purpose. Allotment of work is as per requirement and discretion of NHM Authority.
- All successful bidders are required to conduct service agreement with NHM Authority in prescribed format containing terms and condition of providing service.
- 13. Performance Security: Before allotment of work, the Selected Bidders shall be required to furnish Performance Security (Performance Security) @ 10% of value of work to be allotted for that particular financial year. The performance security shall be required to be issued by any Scheduled Bank drawn in favour of "West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti (A/c NRHM) in prescribed format.

Tender Inviting Authority have right to reject the bid in case of non-submission/incomplete fill up/ no page marking/ not legible/ not in prescribed manner in respect of any Statutory Documents mentioned in Bid A1 above.

# Terms of Reference (ToR):

- National Health Mission is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, funded by Central Govt. and State Govt. in the ratio of 60:40. NHM aims to provide accessible, affordable and quality health care to the people, especially the vulnerable sections. It was first launched by the Government of India in name of National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) on 12th April, 2005 which was later renamed as National Health Mission after incorporation of National Urban Health Mission in year 2013.
- 2. It also supports for strengthening of primary & secondary health care system which reduces morbidity and mortality at much lower costs and significantly reduces the burden on tertiary care. With the transformation of Sub-Centres into Susasthya Kendras, the ambit of delivery of primary healthcare services widens from selective services like reproductive, maternal, neonatal, infant and adolescent health care to comprehensive primary healthcare services covering entire population. Under NHM, special focus is given to screening and early diagnosis of non-communicable diseases especially Diabetes and Hypertension, basic ophthalmic, ENT, dental, geriatric, mental ailments and emergency care.

Apart from above; State Health Societies, District Health Societies and Block Health Societies deal with some other funds such as XV Finance Commission Health Grant, PM-ABHIM Project. MsDP Fund, Covid-19 fund, User charges collected from patient, Jungle Mahal Development Fund(JMDF), Health System Development Initiative(HSDI), Collection related to Medical Education, District Illness Assistance Fund and other health related funds. The auditor has to conduct audit of these funds in addition to the funds under NHM. The auditor is also required to audit any pending units of previous years in addition to audit of current financial year.

# 4. Institutional and Funding Arrangements:



For the implementation of the above programmes, MoH&FW has directed for creation of an Integrated Health Society at State and District levels (registered as a legal entity at the State and District under Societies Registration Act, 1860). In West Bengal there are 341 numbers of Block Health Societies which are also registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 apart from 28 numbers of District Health Societies & one State Health Society.

Such integrated State Health Society (SHS) works in close coordination with the Directorate of Health & Family Welfare whereas District Health Societies (DHS) work in coordination with the District Collector and Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH). Block Health Societies (BHS) work in coordination with the Block Development Officer and Block Medical Officer of Health (CMOH). Program implementation at Block level is done through its Block Primary Health Centre, Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Sub- Centres (SCs), Rogi Kalyan Samities and Village Health & Nutrition Sanitation Committees. Certain activities may be managed at the State level such as drug procurement, IEC, civil works, training using specialized entities such as SIHFW, IEC Bureau, PWD, the Directorate of Health and Municipal Corporations for the urban health components. In addition funds are also released from SHS/ DHS to NGOs and private entities under public private participation (PPP) arrangements.

# Funding & Accounting Arrangements:

Funds for the various programs are transferred from Pay & Accounts Office of MoHFW to the State Treasuries and then from Treasuries to the SHS functioning in the State. Government of India transfer funds in the form of Grants-in-Aid to SHS through State Treasury on the basis of respective State Programme Implementation Plan (SPIPs) and approved Annual Work Plans which are prepared on the basis of Districts' and Blocks' requirement.

# Banking Arrangements & Single Nodal Accounting System:

As per direction of Ministry of Finance, GoI, regarding new procedure for release of fund under Central Sponsored Scheme- National Health Mission, Single Nodal Account System (SNA) has been implemented in F.Y. 2020-21. The system was stated functioning in all Districts from the F.Y. 2021-22. Under this system, limit based allocation has been transferred to Districts and sub-units through web based system whereas physical fund is remained lying under the custody of State Samiti in Single Nodal Account.

The Accounts at each Unit are being maintained on double entry system and Customized version of Tally ERP9 has been used for maintaining books of Accounts.

# Objective of audit services:

The objective of the audit is to implement a system for timely examination of financial transaction on regular basis to ensure accuracy, authenticity, compliance with specified procedure and guidelines. The emphasis under Concurrent Audit is not on test basis but on substantial checking of transaction so that fraud and misappropriation can be identified at initial level.



- 6. Standards: The audit will be carried out in accordance with Engagement & Quality Control Standards (Audit & Assurance Standards) issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India in this regard. The auditor should accordingly consider materiality when planning and performing (except where a certain minimum coverage of implementing units is specified) the audit to reduce the risk to an acceptable level that is consistent with the objective of the audit.
- 7. Audit firms eligible for apply: CA Firm and CMA Firm may only apply for empanelment under this tender. In case of CA Firm who are empanelled with C& AG for the FY 2024-25 may apply for empanelment under this tender. In case of CMA Firm who have completed incorporation of Firm for more than 5 year as on date of issue of this NIT, may apply for empanelment under this tender.
- 8. Scope & Coverage of audit: Concurrent Audit of all units are to be conducted on quarterly basis. As per approval competent authority, Concurrent Audit has been extended to the different units of NHM (i.e. SH&FWS, DH&FWS, BH&FWS, ULBs, MCH, DH/SDH/SGH, DFWO, CTO etc.) and scope and coverage of audit is as follows:

# Points to be considered:

- At least two audit staffs is required to be deputed for conducting audit at Municipality level, Block/ MCH/ DH/ SDH/ Municipal Corporation Level. At least three audit staffs is required to be deputed for conducting audit of District Level/KMC/DFWO/CTO/ State HQ. In case of audit of District Level/KMC/DFWO/CTO/ State HQ, qualified CA/CMA is required to be deputed along-with other audit staff.
- Numbers units mentioned above is approximate which may be increased or decreased time to time.
- > Auditor has to submit audit report on quarterly basis for each unit separately in prescribed format. Format of audit report will be shared at time of issue appointment letter.
- Concurrent Auditors appointed for a district will scrutinize the concurrent audit reports of all units under the district and will prepare a summary report on major observations for inclusion in audit report of District.
- Concurrent Auditors appointed for SH&FWS will scrutinize the concurrent audit reports of all units and will prepare a summary report on major observations inclusion in audit report of State HQ.
- > Two copies of reports shall have to be submitted in hard copy to the respective units along with soft copy in CD.
- Immediately on submission of the concurrent audit report, one endorsed copy (along with the soft copy in CD) should be submitted by the auditors to the next higher level of unit audited.
- All required work of Concurrent Audit shall be distributed between all emended CA Firm selected through this tender process and work shall be distributed on the basis of location and performance of audit unit. Distribution of work shall be sole discretion of NHM Authority no interference of empanelled Audit Firm shall be allowed.
- Empanelled Audit Firm through this tender may also be engaged for special audit of any units or other professional work if required during the valid period of empanelment. In this case, audit fees will be fixed by authority on basis of man days at the rate of minimum fees prescribed by ICIA/ ICMA.

# 9. Reporting and Timing

The reporting format and timing of reporting will be communicated at time of issue appointment. Though it is time bound programme so assignment shall be completed within time line.

10. Audit Fees and TA/DA: The firms those are interested to be appointed, will have to quote audit fees including all expenses on TA/DA and other incidental charges in prescribed format of BoQ. Bidding



Firm should ensure that Audit Team shall have to visit all units and to make 100% vouching. The Audit Fee should be quoted considering all these aspects. In any situation, boarding and lodging charges of audit team shall not be borne by Audit Units and so, it should be included in audit fees quoted by the bidder.

12. The Director Finance, NHM is authorized to issue necessary correspondence in respect of this tender.

### Selection Process:

For the purpose of the empanelment of Audit Firm (i.e. CA / CMA Firm) under NHM for F.Y. 2024-25 and onward, following points shall be taken into account-

- 1) Open advertisement in leading newspapers at State level and National level for inviting proposals from CA/ CMA Firm for Concurrent Audit under NHM has been issued. A copy of the advertisement has also been emailed to the ICAI and ICMA for webhosting on their website. Advertisement along with the detailed tender notice shall also to be uploaded on the state's health website.
- A pre-bid conference shall be held (date to be indicated in the advertisement) wherein clarifications that the potential bidders shall be clarified.
- 3) NHM Authority has formed a Selection Committee in this regard with suitable representation from programme and finance wings. The Selection Committee should invariably headed by members as nominated by the Mission Director. The Selection Committee will subsequently monitor the audit process and the follow up on audit paras and Action Taken Reports on those audit paras.
- 4) The selection process of auditor shall be subject to review by Financial Management Group, MOHFW, GOI / Office of Chief Controller of Accounts, MOHFW, GOI / Audit parties of the AG or any authorized person of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

If required, necessary justification may also be asked during evaluation of bid. In case of non-submission of these documents, the position of bidder may be reduced accordingly.
- 10) The selection will be done considering the Technical and Financial Bid submitted by the bidders. The CA/ CMA firms securing less than cut off marks 50% in technical evaluation will not be qualified in the technical bid and their Financial Bid will not be opened. The firms, who will be qualified in technical bid, are enlisted in website of e-tender.
- 11) Only I1 bidders are selected for empanelment but maximum of fifteen (15) L1 bidders on basis of higher murks in technical bid. In case of less than 15 (fifteen) numbers of L1 bidder, only L1 bidders are selected for empanelment. In case of more than 15 (fifteen) numbers of L1 bidder, fifteen L1 Firms securing higher marks than other bidder, are only selected for empanelment. In case of tie in score of higher technical bid out of fifteen L1 bidders, the selection of successful bidders shall be made as per norms of Order No. 2320-F(Y) dated 07-06-2022 issued by Finance Department, GoWB.
- 12) In case, the bidding firm is found not suitable for audit on any reasonable ground or any information by the MoH&FW/ ICAI/ ACMA/ any Department of State Govt., authority may reject such proposal without giving any reason.
