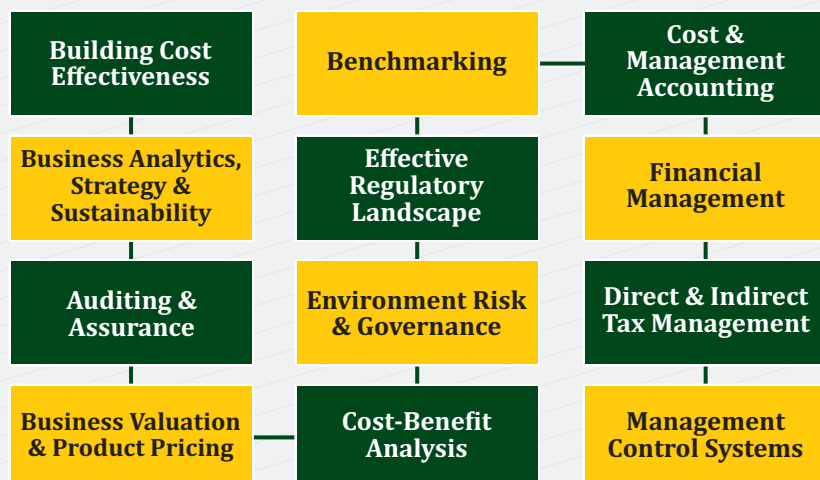

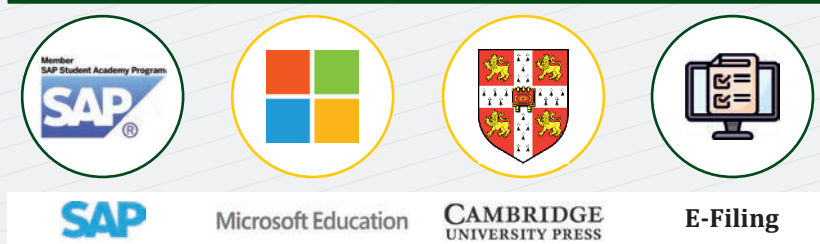
Campus Placements Statistics at a Glance: 2021 & 2022
